The God Who Won't Stay Away: The Tabernacle

Ex. 24

¹⁵ When Moses went up on the mountain, the cloud covered it, ¹⁶ and the glory of the LORD settled on Mount Sinai. For six days the cloud covered the mountain, and on the seventh day the LORD called to Moses from within the cloud.

¹⁷ To the Israelites the glory of the LORD looked like a consuming fire on top of the mountain. ¹⁸ Then Moses entered the cloud as he went on up the mountain. And he stayed on the mountain forty days and forty nights.

⁵ ram skins dyed red and another type of durable leather; acacia wood; ⁶ olive oil for the light; spices for the anointing oil and for the fragrant incense; ⁷ and onyx stones and other gems to be mounted on the ephod and breastpiece.

⁸ “Then have them make a sanctuary for me, and I will dwell among them. ⁹ Make this tabernacle and all its furnishings exactly like the pattern I will show you.

- “And God said” in Gen 1: 3, 6, 9, 14, 20, 24, 26 (see vv. 11, 28, 29) with “And the LORD said” in Ex 25: 1; 30: 11, 17, 22, 34; 31: 1, 12.

- Just as the seventh day of creation climaxed with the Sabbath (Gen 2: 3), so the seventh speech climaxes with instructions about the Sabbath (Ex 31: 12-17).
