



An endless bombardment of news and gossip and images has rendered us manic information addicts. It broke me. It might break you, too.




There are books to read; landscapes to be walked; friends to be with; life to be fully lived....But this new epidemic of distraction is our civilization's specific weakness.




And its threat is not so much to our minds, even as they shapeshift under the pressure. The threat is to our souls. At this rate, if the noise does not relent, we might even forget we have any.
