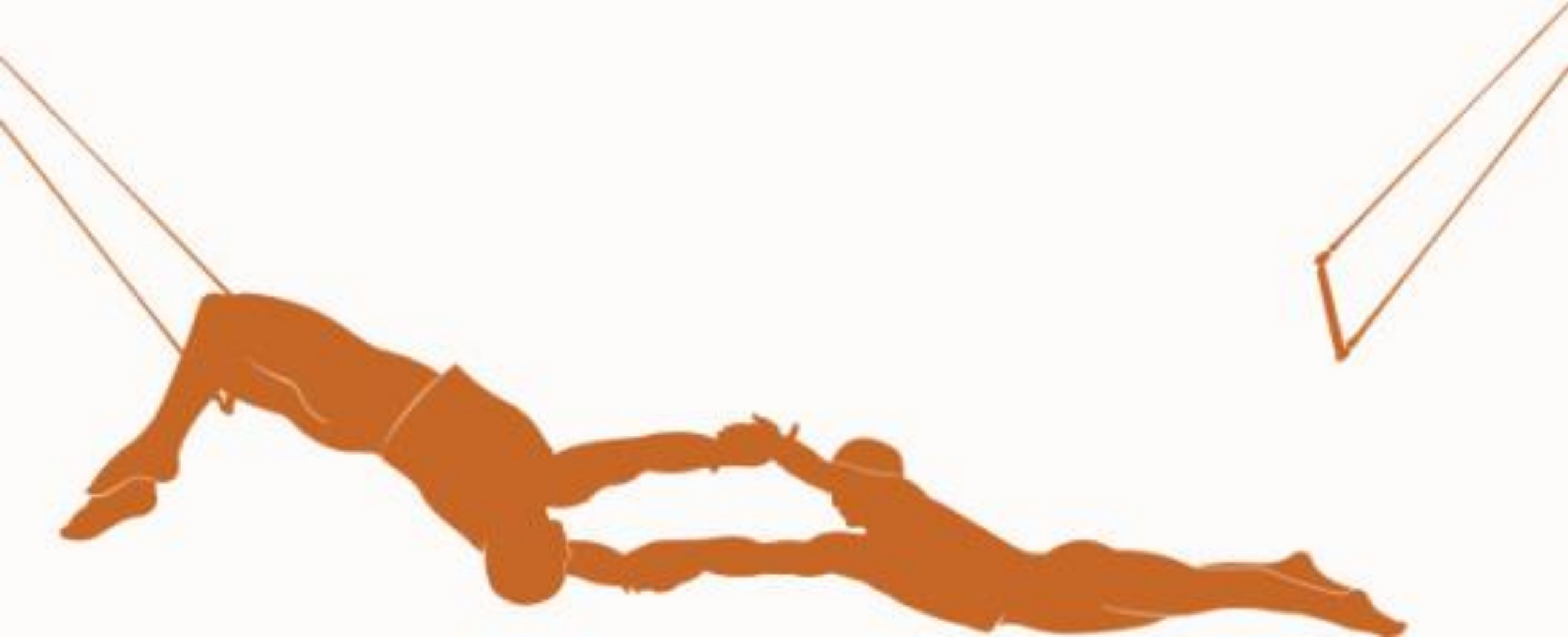

Pressed and heated

Transfer

verb

trans'fər, 'transfər/

1. move from one place to another.
2. change to another place, route, or means of transportation during a journey.

noun

'tran(t)sfər/

1. an act of moving something or someone to another place.
2. a small colored picture or design on paper that can be transferred to another surface by being **pressed or heated**.

Pressed and heated

- * refiner's fire (fashioning)
