


## Dead Bones Can't Walk Genesis 50:22-26















As The National reported yesterday, the Oasis hospital was set up in 1960, when no professional medical care was available and the small Al Ain population suffered from high infant and maternal mortality rates. But hospitals like Oasis are not only essential public facilities, they are the beating hearts of the communities they serve.

As people and businesses come and go, and towns expand into cities, hospitals are constants. They witness the passing of one generation and the birth of another. They are places of profound sadness and of great joy. The Oasis Hospital may be moving into modern premises, but it will remain the soul of Al Ain society and a repository of its many stories.

Then Joseph said to his brothers, "I am about to die. But God will surely come to your aid and take you up out of this land to the land he promised on oath to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob." And Joseph made the Israelites swear an oath and said, "God will surely come to your aid, and then you must carry my bones up from this place." So Joseph died at the age of a hundred and ten. And after they embalmed him. he was placed in a coffin in Egypt.

Now Joseph and all his brothers and all that generation died, but the Israelites were exceedingly fruitful; they multiplied greatly, increased in numbers and became so numerous that the land was filled with them. Then a new king, to whom Joseph meant nothing, came to power in Egypt...

When Pharaoh let the people go, God did not lead them on the road through the Philistine country, though that was shorter. For God said, "If they face war, they might change their minds and return to Egypt." So God led the people around by the desert road toward the Red Sea. The Israelites went up out of Egypt ready for battle.

Moses took the bones of Joseph with him because Joseph had made the Israelites swear an oath. He had said, "God will surely come to your aid, and then you must carry my bones up with you from this place."

By faith Joseph, when his end was near, spoke about the exodus of the Israelites from Egypt and gave instructions concerning the burial of his bones.

Key truth: We can be carrying a legacy and yet the power of the legacy can be neglected when we are in the midst of our own story.

Father, my prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one. They are not of the world, even as I am not of it. Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth.

As you have sent me into the world, I have sent them into the world.
