
HUMAN BEINGS

weapons. —John 18:3




Now the betrayer had arranged a








Then everyone deserted him

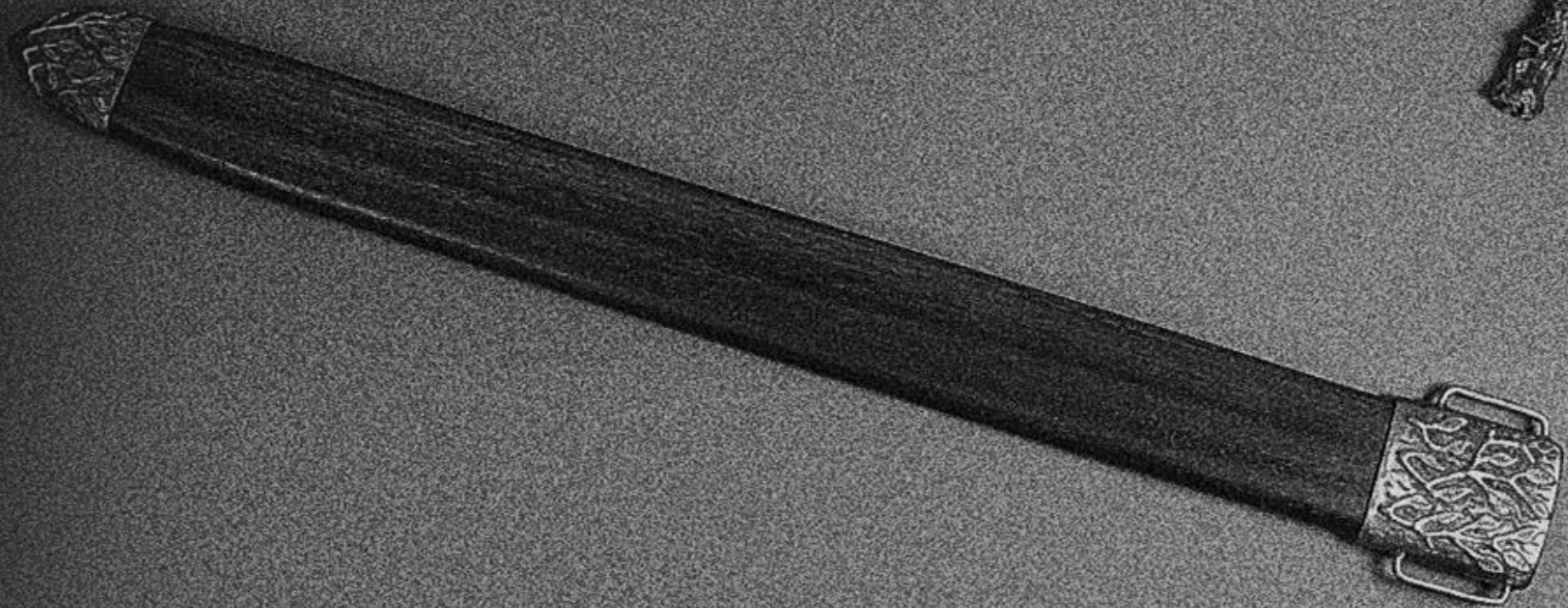
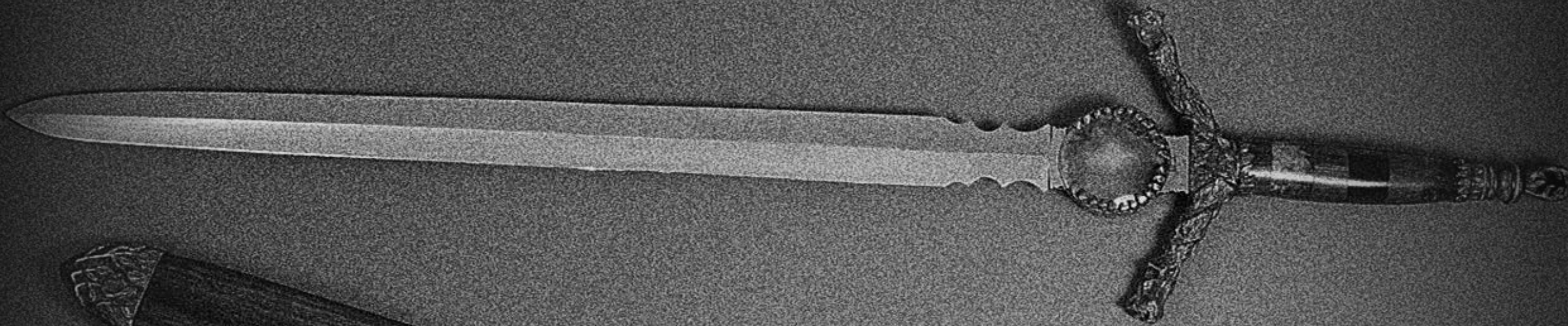



Now when Joshua was near Jericho,


