10:30 a.m. for Children: Kids' Worship and Sunday School Drop your children off in BI before the service or keep them with you during the first part of the service and they will be dismissed to children’s Sunday School mid-service. **Please pick your child up from their classroom in a timely manner after the service.**

Pre-Kindergarten - 1st Grade classes meet in the room across from the men's restroom and classes for 2nd - 5th Grade meet downstairs in BI. If you're visiting during either service, please fill out a Cherub/Junior Church Attendance Card, located in the pew rack, and bring your child to meet their teacher in the narthex when the children are dismissed from the service.

A staffed Nursery for infants and toddlers is available during the entirety of both services.
