Pre-Kindergarten - 1st Grade classes meet in the room across from the men's restroom and classes for 2nd - 5th Grade meet downstairs in B1. If you're visiting during either service, please fill out a Cherub/Junior Church Attendance Card, located in the pew rack, and bring your child to meet their teacher in the narthex when the children are dismissed from the service.

A staffed Nursery for infants and toddlers is available during the entirety of both services.
