Welcome Guests To better connect with you we encourage you to complete a guest registration card located in the pew pockets. You may drop it in the offering plate OR bring it to welcome center in the lobby so that we can greet you and give you a welcome packet.

“Where do my children go during worship?”

Kindergarten through 5th grade will be joining us for the first part of the service and then will be released to their classes mid-service. Cherub Church (k-grade 2) meets in the class across from the men's restroom and Junior Church (grades 3-5) will be meeting in Room B1. **Please pick your child up from their classroom in a timely manner after the service.** If you're visiting, please fill out a Cherub/Junior Church Attendance Card, located in the pew rack, and bring your child to meet their teacher near the coffee bar/welcome center when the children are dismissed from the service.

A combined Children's Sunday School Class for Kindergarten through 5th Grade will meet in the Cherub Church room. We ask that you sign these children out promptly after Sunday School dismisses at 10:00 a.m. A preschool class will meet in the room next to the ladies' restroom. A staffed nursery for toddlers and babies will also be provided during Sunday School.

The Capital Area Pregnancy Center's 2018 Walk for Life will be held on October 5, 2018 at Vibrant Church in Mechanicsburg, beginning at 6:30 p.m. It is a two mile event that raises funds for CAPC which provides a 24 hour Helpline, ultrasounds, pregnancy testing, adoption referrals, baby materials, confidential peer counseling, and post-abortion support.
