








Macha Mission Hospital Pediatric Malaria Admissions

AIDS at Macha Hospital

- First AIDS patients 1986
- For 19 years compassionate care but no treatment for the disease
- · 20% of adults infected
- · 4% newly infected each year

Death Sentence

- Funeral every week
- 5-7 hospital staff members died each year





ART Clinic - opened March 2005



ARV treatment stops transmission

 Prevents transmission of the disease from HIV+ mother to child at birth

With no ARVs 40% babies infected

 With ARVs no babies infected from Macha Hospital Antenatal Clinic in the past 6 years.




