- ◆ Help set up and tear down bedrooms and living areas for our guests (Conclusion of church on Oct. 28 and 7am on Nov. 4)
- ◆ Supply lunch and snack foods for guests during week (sign-up sheet)
- ◆ Provide dinners for guests and dinner hosts (Main Dish, and/or Side Dish and Dessert)
- ◆ Eating and spending time with the guests during dinner (6pm-8:15pm)
- ◆ Staying overnight (*sleeping*) on our air mattresses in a private room (8pm-6:30am)
- ◆ Driving our guests back to the Day Center in FP Van
- ◆ Playing games with kids during evening hosting time (varies)
- ◆ After our guests leave, helping to launder and fold the soiled sheets and blankets.

Welcome Guests To better connect with you we encourage you to complete a guest registration card located in the pew pockets. You may drop it in the offering plate OR bring it to welcome center in the lobby so that we can greet you and give you a welcome packet.

“Where do my children go during worship?”

Kindergarten through 5th grade will be joining us for the first part of the service and then will be released to their classes mid-service. Cherub Church (k-grade 2) meets in the class across from the men's restroom and Junior Church (grades 3-5) will be meeting in Room B1. **Please pick your child up from their classroom in a timely manner after the service.** If you're visiting, please fill out a Cherub/Junior Church Attendance Card, located in the pew rack, and bring your child to meet their teacher near the coffee bar/welcome center when the children are dismissed from the service.

A combined Children’s Sunday School Class for Kindergarten through 5th Grade will meet in the Cherub Church room. We ask that you sign these children out promptly after Sunday School dismisses at 10:00 a.m. A preschool class will meet in the room next to the ladies’ restroom. A staffed nursery for toddlers and babies will also be provided during Sunday School.

Ingathering Offering: On October 28th, we will receive an in-gathering offering that will be for the capital campaign fund. These funds go to the development and care of our physical space and enable us to minister to the congregation and reach out to the community. In the weeks ahead, we will be highlighting some of the congregational ministries that use our space.

Van Drivers needed for Family Promise, October 28 - November 4, 2018. We are in need of drivers for both the morning run and the afternoon run. You do not have to drive both times during the day. The only prerequisite is a valid driver’s license.
