On April 6th we will be hosting a mandated reporter training from 11 a.m. - 2:30 p.m. A mandated reporter is an adult required to report suspected child abuse if they have reasonable cause to suspect that a child is a victim of child abuse. If you volunteer in Children's or Youth Ministry, you **are** a mandated reporter. This training promotes child safety by increasing the knowledge of mandated reporters regarding the identification of the signs of abuse and neglect and explaining the process for reporting abuse. If you have not had this training in the past, we strongly urge you to sign up. The training is **FREE** and a free lunch will be provided.
