<sup>9</sup> If the ministry that brought condemnation was glorious, how much more glorious is the ministry that brings righteousness!

# <sup>10</sup> For what was glorious has no glory now in comparison with the surpassing glory.

<sup>11</sup> And if what was transitory came with glory, how much greater is the glory of that which lasts!

# <sup>12</sup> Therefore, since we have such a hope, we are very bold.

<sup>13</sup> We are not like Moses, who would put a veil over his face to prevent the Israelites from seeing the end of what was passing away.

<sup>14</sup> But their minds were made dull, for to this day the same veil remains when the old covenant is read. It has not been removed, because only in Christ is it taken away.

<sup>15</sup> Even to this day when Moses is read, a veil covers their hearts. <sup>16</sup> But whenever anyone turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away.

# <sup>17</sup>Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.

<sup>18</sup> And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate (reflect) the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his image with everincreasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.

### Spirit =Freedom

• If it is true that where the Spirit of the Lord, there is freedom, and if we have the Spirit of the Lord, it seems only logical to conclude that we have freedom
