Look at Romans 14. How does Paul talk about weak and strong?

What do you think of the idea of the Bible as a means of grace?

If it is a means of grace, what does that mean for our Bible habits?

**If and only if** your group is healthy and diverse, you may want to talk about the issues in DC. Care must be taken so that damage to individuals, relationships, or to the group does not occur. If the group is rather homogenous on the issue, there is really no reason to discuss it.

Regardless of whether the DC issues are discussed, what does it mean for us to have the same mind as Christ in this (Rom. 15. 5,6)? What does it look like for us to be of one mind and voice?
