Mask and Social Distancing Requirements: During outdoor worship, we are no longer requiring masks for those who are fully vaccinated, although we are asking you to please be extra-attentive and sensitive to others' personal space. During indoor worship services, we are asking that everyone in the **Sanctuary and Orange Room (basement)** keep their masks on throughout the worship service. In the Fellowship Hall, face shields may be used if medically necessary and face masks or shields may be removed once you are seated. Social distancing should be observed throughout the building.
