CANDLE LIGHTING NOTE:

The central candle in the Advent wreath represents Christ, the Light of the World. During the singing of *Silent Night*, the light will be passed to the candles of the worshippers nearest the center aisle who will then light the next candle in the row and so on.

When all the candles are lit, we will bow and silently pray together, asking God to help us shine so that others may come to live in the light of Jesus our Savior and Lord. After the prayer, we will stand and join together in singing *Joy to the World*.

Following the benediction, please extinguish your candles for safety purposes, but let us leave the sanctuary with Christ's light burning in our lives as we take his light into the world.
