#### Gal. 5.13-26

<sup>13</sup> You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love.

#### <sup>14</sup> For the entire law is fulfilled in keeping this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself."

# <sup>15</sup> If you bite and devour each other, watch out or you will be destroyed by each other.

# <sup>16</sup> So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh.

<sup>17</sup> For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want.

### <sup>18</sup> But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.

<sup>19</sup> The acts of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; <sup>20</sup> idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions<sup>21</sup> and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like.

#### I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God.

<sup>22</sup> But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness and self-control.
Against such things there is no law.

<sup>24</sup> Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

### <sup>25</sup> Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.

# <sup>26</sup> Let us not become conceited, provoking and envying each other.

<sup>16</sup> If you see any brother or sister commit a sin that does not lead to death, you should pray and God will give them life.

<sup>19</sup> We know that we are children of God, and that the whole world is under the control of the evil one. <sup>21</sup> Dear children, keep yourselves from idols.

<sup>20</sup> We know also that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding, so that we may know him who is true. And we are in him who is true by being in his Son Jesus Christ. He is the true God and eternal life.
