Embodied Repentance *Luke 19:1-10*

1. If you have time in your group, read through the Scripture passage again. What stands out to you?
2. Why do you think Zacchaeus was quick to respond to the invitation of Jesus? If you were in the crowd that day, how might you have responded?
3. Have you ever experienced a revival or been inspired by stories from a revival? What are your hopes or concerns as we look for God to move in our midst?
4. Depending on the time and trust level in your group, explore some of the “pay attention to the tug” questions together:
 - Where are you being pulled?
 - What are you drawn to?
 - What are you hungry for?
 - Where are you hurting?
 - Where do you feel most alive?
 - When do you sense the joy and delight of God?
5. How can you “lean into the turn” this week? Where might you encounter the presence of Jesus? Who could you invite to come alongside you?
6. Share some practical ways you can “move toward the good.” What ideas do you have for being intentional about repenting and returning to God?
