 - Where do you feel most alive?
 - When do you sense the joy and delight of God?
- 5. How can you "lean into the turn" this week? Where might you encounter the presence of Jesus? Who could you invite to come alongside you?
- 6. Share some practical ways you can "move toward the good." What ideas do you have for being intentional about repenting and returning to God?
