Christ's Birthday Offering - We will continue to accept offerings for the Christ's Birthday Offering this week. The offering will be divided between Local and Global Outreach projects.

Local Outreach will again use their portion to fund scholarships for local student. The scholarship(s) will be given to individuals who are nontraditional students pursuing either college or trade school training; where non-traditional means they are either not in a college preparatory academic program, or perhaps are returning to school as an older student or with a General Equivalency Diploma rather than a traditional high school diploma.

The Global portion will be shared between Global Compassion Fund, which enables quick responses to needs, conflicts and disasters around the world, and SPICE, the Scholarship Program for Indian Children's Education. This money helps poor rural children of Brethren in Christ families in India and Nepal be able to attend school in a nearby town and live in a sheltered, Christian hostel. This is an old program, and some SPICE graduates have grown up to be church leaders.

In case of inclement weather, the policy of DBIC is to cancel any in-person morning activities if Northern York School District is on a 2-hour delay.
