There are three key concepts from the message

Pleasure

The sensed-based enjoyment of an experience that causes joy and gratitude.

Desire

The drive that goes after our "wants." In our sexuality we not only want things (pleasure, intimacy, etc.) we want to be wanted.

Intimacy

The core-longing to be know and be known without pretense, hiddenness, or shame

What might your EYE or HAND be this week? (What is the thing God might be calling you to remove so that you can know pleasure, desire, and intimacy, his way or in a better way?

How might you experience these wants being met apart from your sexuality?
