Witnessing to the Light
Luke 2:1-20

1. Read this familiar Scripture together. Does anything stand out to you? What do you wonder about?

We witness to the light when we open our hearts to the activity of God, when we seek and find the face of God, and when we treasure and tell others of the love of God.

2. **Open:** How open do you feel to the activity of God in your life? Do you long to see or experience him more? How might we become more open to noticing his movement? How can we, like Joseph and Mary, hold our tidy plans more loosely?
3. **Seek:** What do you think about the idea that these were temple shepherds watching over sacrificial lambs? Why did they persist in seeking and finding the baby in the manger? When and where do you see the face of God (his beauty, glory, grace)?
4. **Treasure:** Are you a talker like the shepherds or a ponder-er like Mary? How are you wired to witness: through words, actions, generosity, prayer? What might it look like to lean into those gifts? What might it look like to move outside of your comfort zone to witness to the light and love of God?
5. Close with prayer and know that you are loved!
