Psalm 84: Valleys

1. Read this psalm aloud together. What stands out to you? What do you wonder about?
2. **Tell:** What do think about the story of Korah and his sons? Have you ever struggled to accept your place or position? Do you have a story of generational significance to tell?
3. **Telos:** Do you agree that our main purpose in life is to praise and worship God? Has there ever been a time when you experienced a deep longing for the presence of God?
4. **Travel:** Do you connect with the idea of having your “heart set on pilgrimage”? Why or why not? Have you ever felt God’s nearness in a season of wilderness? What was that like?
5. **Trust:** Does trust come easily for you, or not? Which of the four words in v. 11 (sun, shield, grace, glory) have you known God to be in your life?
6. Close with prayer, and if you are feeling creative, try saying some *dayenu* prayers: “Lord God, if you had... but not... it would have been enough.”
